Aged Care Dual Qualification

CHC30208 Certificate III in Aged Care
CHC30308 Certificate III in Home & Community Care

These nationally recognised qualifications are delivered part-time and are aimed at people who wish to work as personal care assistants within aged care facilities or in the community with elderly or disabled persons.

Personal care assistants work in supported accommodation settings such as nursing homes, hostels and day centres, private homes, boarding houses or independent living units.

Duties include providing assistance with physical activities such as bathing, dressing, mobility, grooming and eating.

In community settings carers may also assist with personal care, shopping, cooking, home care and other activities involved with daily living and recreation.

Community Information Workers

CHCCS416A Assess and provide services for clients with complex needs

This course aims to provide formal training for people who are currently working in the field of community information provision. This includes workers in Community Information and Support Centres (CISC or CAB), in both paid and voluntary positions, as well as people who provide information to the community in their capacity as workers in a variety of human services fields.

Children's Services

CHC30708 Certificate III in Children's Services

This nationally recognised qualification is delivered part-time and is aimed at people who are working or wish to work with children. This course involves the use of organisational policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling them to achieve their developmental outcomes.

CHC50908 Diploma of Children's Services (Early childhood education and care)

This nationally recognised qualification covers workers in children's services who are responsible for planning, implementing and managing programs in early childhood services, in accordance with licensing, accreditation and duty of care requirements. Workers have responsibility for supervision of other staff and volunteers and in most states it is the highest qualification required at director or service manager level for children's service centre based care.

Education Support

CHC30808 Certificate III in Education Support

This nationally recognised qualification is aimed at those who wish to increase their understanding of and involvement with children with disabilities.

The course develops strong knowledge and skills about inclusive learning practices for children with disabilities and an understanding about a wide range of disabilities and their impact upon learning and social development.

Participants will become skilled in the practices and processes needed to support the broad development of children with disabilities both academically and emotionally.
