Additional Fees:

- As a condition of work placement the learner may be required to undergo a Working with Children Check or a Police Check at their own expense
- RPL application fee of \$200 will be charged at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable if the applicant is assessed as not yet competent.
- To re-issue each Certificate or Statement of Attainment there will be a charge of \$30 to cover administration costs for Certificates 5 years and under. Any Certificate over 5 years old will incur a \$300 fee to reissue.

Note: There are two delivery options for the Diploma:
 The 'Working' model: 1 -2 Saturdays per month for 12 months for those who are working a minimum of 14 hours in Childcare or Kindergarten setting. Must hold either CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care; or CHCE30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care;
 The 'Non-Working' model - 2 days per week plus 1 day placement. Must hold either CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care; or CHCE30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.
